



Headteacher’s Message

As we reach the end of the penultimate week, I realise things are getting more complicated! The children and staff have worked so hard on their Christmas performances and we are very excited to perform them next week (with the usual hiccups along the way I’m sure!) We have been closely following the local and national guidance and we re confident that we are able to go ahead with our performances next week. The community centre is large enough for us to spread out, and we are limiting numbers to 2 adults per family. 
